



Moving Hands Scholarship

Individuals fluent in American Sign Language and/or Signed Exact English may be eligible to receive a full scholarship to a NOLS Wilderness Medicine classroom course in Wilderness First Aid (WFA), Wilderness First Responder (WFR), or Wilderness First Responder-Recertification (WFR-R) course. Scholarships cover tuition only. If interpretation is requested, submit your application 12 weeks prior to the start date of your desired course. In all cases, allow two weeks for your application to be evaluated. If your application is approved, you will receive enrollment and payment directions to pay the appropriate deposit or tuition, which will be refunded upon course completion. Enrollment on a course is based upon availability. The scholarship is awarded a maximum of two times.
