Parking for the Black Rock Visitor Center is clearly marked. Please follow the signs.

A National Park pass is *not* required to visit the Black Rock Nature Center.

A National Park pass is *required* to enter the park and camp within the National Park. These passes can be purchased either at the Visitor Centers or the entrance kiosks to the National Park

This course will be taught <u>entirely or mostly outdoors</u>. Tables and chairs will not be provided in the outdoor environment. Students are advised to bring a folding or backpacking chair with them as well as clothing suitable for the weather. Indoor space for will be available in case of inclement weather and to allow students to store personal gear during the day. Access to restroom facilities and potable water will be available at the course site. Please remember NOLS's new COVID-19 policies require students to bring at minimum two face masks and a pair of googles or sunglasses for eye protection. In addition, students will be supplied with exam gloves and hand sanitizer to reduce communicable disease transmission.

Travel, Meals, and Lodging Meals and Lodging

We do not offer a meals and lodging package for this course. Students are required to arrange all lodging and food.

There are many options for camping or lodging in the Joshua tree area. Many visitors stay in Airbnb's or VRBO's There are also many hotels in the area including the surrounding towns of Yucca Valley, 29 Palms, Desert Hot Springs or even as far away as Palm Springs. The drive from Palm Springs to the Black Rock Nature Center about an hour. A good place to start when searching hotels in the Joshua Tree, Yucca Valley area are Kayak.com, Bookings.com, and tripadvisor.com
