CLASS FORMAT AND PERSONAL PREPAREDNESS

Check-in is 7:45 AM on the first day. Course days run from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. All course materials will be provided on the first morning of the course.

The class format is classroom lectures (primarily outdoors) integrated with practical scenarios, case studies, and skills practice sessions. Attendance is required at all classes.

Scenarios and practice sessions will take place both primarily outdoors with an indoor space available. Bring outdoor clothing appropriate for lying on the potentially wet, snowy, or cold ground playing the role of both rescuer and patient.

Frequently stage (moulage) blood and make-up are used to enhance the realism of a scenario.

Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals and Lodging

Meals and lodging are available for this course. Meals offered are as follows. May 14 – lunch & dinner. May 15 – breakfast & lunch. Lodging will be for the night of the 14th only. Below are the different pricing options:

Tuition only: \$250

Tuition + lodging: \$275

Tuition + lodging & all four meals: \$307

Meals: \$8/meal *Meals typically can't be purchased once at IdRaHaJe. We ask that meals be purchased at least 2 weeks prior to the course start date*

Nearest Camping:

Deer Creek Campground – 8 miles

From Denver, travel US Highway 285 south toward Fairplay for approximately 25 miles to the top of Crow Hill. Turn north onto Park County Road 43A going towards the community of Harris Park. After 7 miles, the road splits; stay left onto the dirt road. The campground will be on your left after 2 miles.

Buffalo Creek – 12 miles away.

3.5 miles south of the small town of Buffalo Creek on County Road 126 (also known as Deckers Rd.) is a turn off west on Forest Road 550 into Pike National Forest. For about 5 miles on Forest Road 550, there are various dispersed free camping sites along both sides of the road until you reach the official National Forest Campground called Buffalo.

From Denver, travel west on highway 285 toward Bailey, CO. At the stop light of county road 43A turn left. There will be a Loaf N Jug gas station on the Northwest corner. The entrance for camp IdRaHaJe will be on the left hand side about ¼ mile down county road 43A. Follow the signs to the course building once on camp.
