### Travel, Meals, and Lodging

- <u>Getting to Fayetteville by Air</u>
  Regional Airports: Raleigh County Memorial Airport: 35 miles or 40 minutes
  International Airports: West Virginia International at Charleston: 60 miles or 1hr 10min drive
- <u>Getting to Fayetteville by Car</u>: This pocket of West Virginia is home to New River Gorge Ntl Park, and it's a little off the beaten path, which makes Fayetteville a perfect destination for a road trip. Here's some information on the drive times to expect.
  - Charleston, WV: 60 miles north | 1-hour drive
  - Columbus, OH: 220 miles northwest | 3.5-hour drive
  - Washington DC: 310 miles northeast | 5-hour drive
  - Raleigh, NC: 282 miles | 4.5-hour drive

Please use this linked <u>MAP of the Outpost property</u> to navigate for parking and finding the classroom. Students that are staying on-site may park in the designated guest areas, or in the lodge parking lot. 'Day-Use' students will need to park in the Day Parking indicated 'PARK HERE' on the map. The star denotes the classroom location at the Lodge.

- Lodging: The Outpost offers both camping and cabin accommodations. The code MRI0524 (mri0524) will take 5% off your lodging reservation. You can book through their <u>website</u> or by phone.
- Hotels and Airbnbs are also abundant in the Fayetteville area. But we do recommend staying on site.

## Refund, Transfer, and Cancellation Policy

MRI charges a \$75 non-refundable application fee, which will be applied to the course tuition. Refunds and transfer requests will be provided based on course type. Deposits are required to secure a space on your course.

*Wilderness First Responder* - Within 30 days of the course start date, the \$300 course deposit is non-transferable and non-refundable. The full tuition balance is due 15 days prior to the course start date.

# **Student Logistics**

No refunds or transfers will be awarded within 15 days of the course start date. **Failure to pay in full for a course by the deadline will result in the cancelation of your registration, and retention of all monies paid.** Outside of 30 days, refunds will be processed upon request minus the \$75 application fee. Transfers will be subject to a \$75 transfer fee. No refunds will be awarded once the course has begun.

*Wilderness First Responder Recertification/Wilderness First Aid* - Full tuition is due at the time of registration to secure a space on these course types. Within 30 days of the course start date, all tuitions are non-transferable and non-refundable. Outside of 30 days, transfer or refund will be subject to the \$75 application fee. Transfers will be subject to a \$75 transfer fee. No refunds will be awarded once the course has begun.

*Course Cancellation* - In the unlikely event of a course cancellation, all tuitions will be refunded minus the \$75 application fee.
