#### Coming from the East (Eagle):

- 1. Start on I-70 Westbound and continue until you reach Exit 140 for Gypsum.
- 2. Take Exit 140, then turn left onto Trail Gulch Road (this will take you over I-70).
- 3. Continue straight until the road becomes Cooley Mesa Road.
- 4. Turn right onto Valley Road and follow the signs to the Gypsum Recreation Center.

#### Coming from the West (Glenwood Springs):

- 1. Start on I-70 Eastbound and head toward Gypsum.
- 2. Take Exit 140 for Gypsum, then turn right onto Trail Gulch Road.
- 3. Continue straight until the road becomes Cooley Mesa Road.
- 4. Turn right onto Valley Road and follow the signs to the Gypsum Recreation Center.
