### Travel, Meals, and Lodging

#### Meals and Lodging

*Wisconsin Conservation Corps is not able to offer housing or camping for this course. There are hotels available nearby. Given the pace of the course, we recommend that all participants pack a lunch and snacks. Food is not provided but there is a refrigerator and microwave to chill and warm food.*

#### Travel

##### **From Downtown La Crosse**

*If you are approaching The Nature Place from downtown, take La Crosse Street going East. You will pass by Rudy's Drive-In and the Oak Grove Cemetery while following the UW-La Crosse campus. Take a left onto Myrick Park Drive and follow it around the Main Shelter and past Kids Coulee Playground down the hill to The Nature Place.*

##### **From Hwy 16**

*If you are approaching The Nature Place from Highway 16, take a right at the lights on La Crosse Street after passing Roellig Park on your right. Take a right onto Myrick Park Drive and follow it around the Main Shelter and past Kids Coulee Playground down the hill to The Nature Place.*

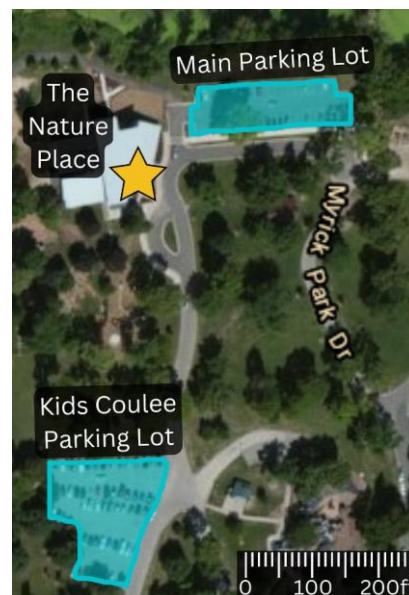
##### **From Losey Boulevard**

*If you are approaching The Nature Place from Losey Boulevard heading North, take a left at the lights on La Crosse Street after passing Forest Hills Golf Course on your right. Take a right onto Myrick Park Drive and follow it around the Main Shelter and past Kids Coulee Playground down the hill to The Nature Place.*

#### **PARKING**

*There are two parking lots near The Nature Place: the Main Parking Lot and the Kids Coulee Parking Lot. The Main Parking Lot is closer to The Nature Place and has designated accessibility spots. The Kids Coulee Parking Lot is on top of the hill and provides many more parking spaces.*

*Myrick Park is a public park, so parking may be limited. There may also be events occurring at The Nature Place, so the Main Parking Lot may be full. If it is, check out the Kids Coulee Parking Lot on top of the hill!*
