## Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals and Lodging

There is a lodging package available for this course that will include meals. Students who do not pay the additional \$100 for lodging are required to arrange all lodging and food on their own. Nearby camping options - St. Louis Creek Campground in Fraser, Idlewild Campground in Winter Park, Arapaho National Recreation Area around Grand Lake. There are a number of hotel/motel options in Granby as well as Fraser and Winter Park.

#### Travel

The course will be held at YMCA of the Rockies - Snow Mountain Ranch inside the Navajo conference room of the Indian Peaks Lodge.

Directions from Denver: Take I-70 West to exit 232 (road signs will read Winter Park, Granby Ranch, Granby, Rocky Mountain National Park). Take exit 232 onto Highway 40 over Berthoud Pass, continue driving west on Highway 40 through Winter Park, Fraser and Tabernash. Four miles west of Tabernash turn left off Highway 40 into the YMCA Snow Mountain Ranch property. Continue driving straight through the four-way stop. At the second junction turn right. Indian Peaks lodge will be the first building you see on the left.
